- **DO NOT** Admit fault or accuse the other party of being at fault
- **DO NOT** refuse to cooperate with the police or other authorities
- **DO NOT** reject being transported to the hospital or other medical facility if you are injured

## WHEN YOU’RE IN AN AUTO ACCIDENT:

### WHAT TO DO:

- Stay calm and check for injuries
- Call the police – even if the accident is minor
- Get insurance information, name, address and phone of the other driver and fill out the form in this brochure
- Get the names, phone numbers and addresses of any witnesses
- Contact your insurance agency and report the claim – check to see if PIP benefits are available to you.
- See a medical provider immediately if you have any complaints of pain
- Contact an attorney to explain your rights and help you with the claims process

**DO NOT** give any recorded or written statements to the insurance company until you have spoken with an attorney

**DO NOT** leave the scene of the accident until the police tell you it is alright to do so

**DO NOT** refuse to see a medical provider because you hope the pain will “go away with time”

**DO NOT** hesitate to contact an attorney to explain your rights and help you with your claim

### WHAT NOW?

Call your insurance agent.

**Ask if you have PIP benefits.** If you do, ask what the limits are and the dollar amount. Typical **PIP** benefits are available for 3 years after the accident and amount to \$10,000 per person.

Ask your agent to start a claim.

Ask your agent to call you back and provide you with the following information:

- Claim number;**
- Address and phone number of the claims office; and**
- The PIP adjuster’s name who will be handling your claim.**

Ask the claims adjuster to mail you or your attorney a **PIP** Application.

You or your attorney needs to complete the **PIP** Application and return it to the claims office.

Keep this information handy and provide your Health Care Providers with the following information:

- Claim number;**
- PIP adjuster’s name; and**
- Claims office address and phone number.**
